# Tech Talk



## Jack Saddles

A lot of folks carry a hydraulic jack in the Model A since the original jacks are far and few between and really not too safe. The problem with using a hydraulic jack is the contact point. On the Model A there is not a safe smooth, wide spot to lift on, neither on the rear axle housings or front axle.

**John Stone** made some saddles for the jacks in his cars, and loaned one to the group that drove to Vancouver this summer. They indeed had a few flats and found the saddle to be very handy and gave them a feeling of safety when they put it to use. They were so impressed that they vowed to make their own when they returned to Wichita.

The cost to make a saddle is practically zero if you have some scrap flat iron, miscellaneous pipe nipples and access to a welder. A, 2" wide by 4" piece of flat iron is needed. Any thickness from 1/8" to 3/16" will work. Bend the ends to a degree that you think will encompass the axle. The pipe required is dependent on the size of the jack that you use. It needs to slip on the stem. In other words make it to fit your jack. Then weld the saddle to the short pipe. When finished it is a good idea to paint the saddle a bright color. Otherwise it would be easy to forget and leave it lying on the road.

It is also a good idea to carry a 2" X 4" or 4" X 4" block in your car to give the base of the jack more lift and stability, especially on soft or uneven surfaces. RG

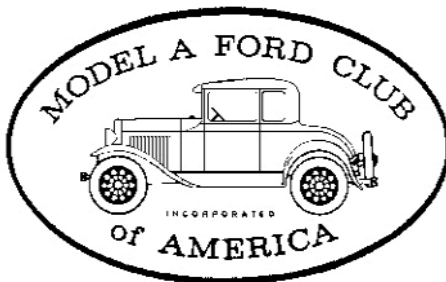
