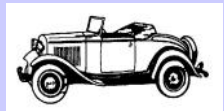

We are certainly hoping for cooler weather to enjoy the When Pigs Fly In & Labor Day Weekend tours.

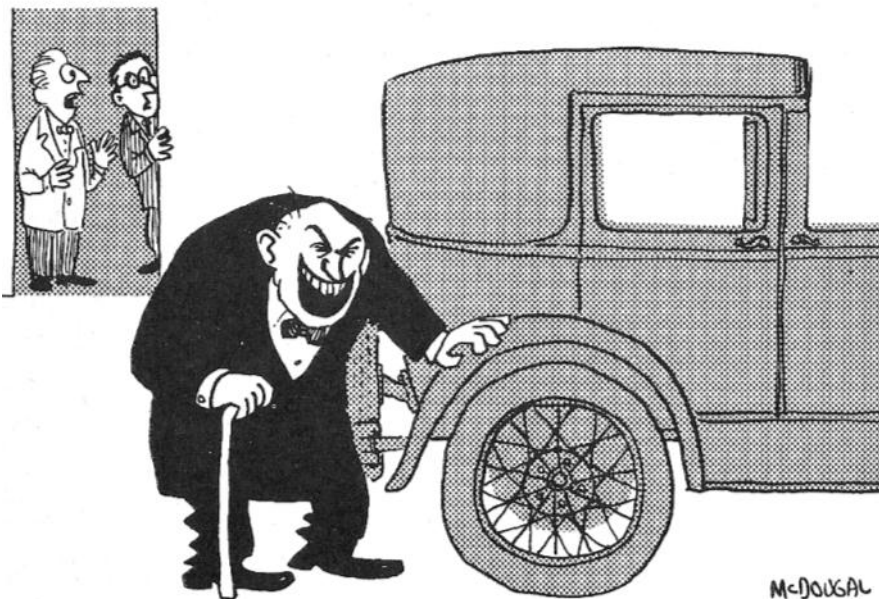

NOTE FROM THE EDITOR

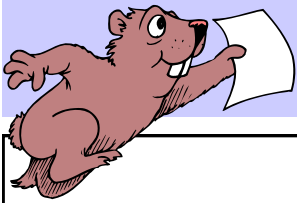

September 2-5, 2011

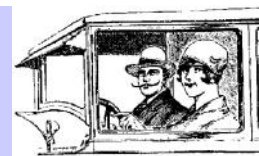

Ugly Truck Day / When: Always July 20th

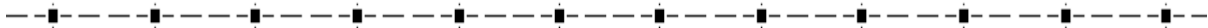
